1. Study The Warning Signs section of the Cancer notes:

The Warning Signs of Cancer

(CLASSIC CAUTION)

- Change in bowel or bladder habits.
- A sore that does not heal.
- Unusual bleeding or discharge.
- Thickening or a lump in the breast, or elsewhere.
- Indigestion or difficulty in swallowing.
- Obvious change in a wart or mole.
- Nagging cough or hoarseness.

(The Updated CAUTIONS)

- Change in Mole
- Abnormal Discharge
- Unilateral Pain
- Tumor
- Increasing Lymph Gland
- Overwhelming Fatigue
- Neurological Deficit
- Subtle and Persistent changes
