OLD DEFINITION: DEPENDENCE ON A SUBSTANCE (DRUG) TO WHICH THE BODY DEVELOPS A TOLERANCE AND SHOWS WITHDRAWAL WHEN DEPRIVED OF IT.

NEW DEFINITION: ADDS A CONCEPT AND NOW INCLUDES BEHAVIORS THAT PEOPLE TURN TO FOR RELIEF OF <u>DISTRESS</u> AND CONTINUE TO RELY ON DESPITE <u>NEGATIVE</u> EFFECTS ON THEIR EMOTIONAL OR SOCIAL FUNCTIONING.

WE USED TO SAY PHYSICALLY ADDICTED AND EMOTIONALLY DEPENDENT. NOW ADDICTION IS USED FOR ALL.
