Scientific Name Generic or Common Name Trade Name

Scientific Name - A unique name that tells a scientist the exact structure of a compound (or drug).

Generic Name - A drug name that is familiar and everyone uses.

Trade Name - The registered (trade mark) name that is owned and used by the company that makes the drug.
