Bulldog puts runners on par

PARAMUS — Many Bergen and Passaic cross-country leagues, county, and invitational championships are held at Garret Mountain. But another course in Bergen County, the Bergen Community College course at Orchard Hills Golf Club, will enhance its reputation Saturday with the Bulldog Invitational.

It's the eighth Bulldog Invitational, but only the fourth at BCC. The meet was run at Garret Mountain the first four years until BCC track and cross-country coach Don Bozzone received permission to move the race to the college.

"We always wanted to run it there, but because it's on a functioning golf course, we couldn't make arrangements the first few years," said Bozzone. "But the people at the course have graciously helped us the rest of the time

and they've even supplied me with a golf cart."

"The footing is very good, because the runners run over a lot of fairways. And it's not boring because there are a lot of turns and hills. The spectators can get a good look at the runners here as well."

In the three previous years, some of the top runners in New Jersey have competed on the course. Cesar Gaudin of Union Hill, the 1986 Group 3 champion set the boys course record of 15 minutes, 41.5 seconds in 1986. Group 2 girls champion Christi Constantin of Kittatinny won her second consecutive title last year, setting a course record of 18:31.8.

Constantin returns this year and should easily break her course record for the third consecutive year. The senior is also favored to win the New Jersey state scholastic title this year.

Defending team champions

Paramus Catholic (Boys A), River Dell (Boys B), Hackensack (Girls A), and Horace Mann (Girls B) return to the meet. Paramus Catholic and Horace Mann are expected to contend for the title this year.


Mark Bednarz of Paramus Catholic is expected to win the race this year and perhaps challenge Gaudin's record. Defending champion Rich Wisse of Saddle Brook will miss the B race because he's recovering from an emergency appendectomy, but Rob Lipchus of Rutherford and Steve Samouhos of Fort Lee should be among

the leaders.

Ridgewood should win the Girls B race with Jean Hughes and Lynne Collazo contending for the individual title. Constantin could run fast enough in the Girls B race to finish in the top 10 of the Boys B race.

In other meets, Morris Catholic's R.J. Ryerson, who won impressively at last week's Season Opener at Garret, will challenge defending state champion Jason DiJoseph of Paul VI Haddonfield at the Philadelphia Textile Invitational at Fairmount Park in Philadelphia.

Parity the word for group meet

The weatherman is not optimistic about the forecast for Saturday's 35th renewal of the Bergen County Cross-Country Championships at Garret Mountain in West Paterson.

If the expected rain occurs, it could wreak havoc with predicted form at the meet, which is scheduled to begin with the Group 3 girls race at 10:10 a.m. and end with the Group 2 boys race at 1:15 p.m.

Several perennial team champions are expected to win easily Saturday, with Ridgewood likely to win its eighth Group 4 title in the past nine years. But there may also be some first-time winners in the meet, with the Waldwick, Rutherford, and Paramus boys the most likely candidates.

Individually, although six of last year's eight champions were underclassmen, only Ken Flynn of Ramsey (Group 3), Dee Keough of Mahwah (Group 2 girls) and Jean Hughes of Ridgewood (Group 4 girls) are expected to repeat.

Here's a look at the meet, race by race (starting time in parentheses):

Group 3 girls (10:10 a.m.) — Paramus shoots for its third championship in four years, but faces a tough test from undefeated Ramsey, Bergen County Scholastic League American (defending Group 2) champion Dumont, and Bergenfield.

Vickee Foy of Paramus should battle Keri Riley of Northern Highlands, Kathy McAuliffe of Dumont, Lora Matteis of Cliffside Park, and Kim Sheekey of Ramsey in the most wide-open individual race of the day.

Group 4 girls (10:30) — Ho, hum! Ridgewood will romp again, for the fifth straight time with Hughes and Lynne Collazo going 1-2. The other two team spots, which would qualify the teams for the upcoming Meet of Champions, could go to any of the six other schools in the race, with Fair Lawn having an edge.

and Pascack Hills should contend for the third slot.

Group 4 boys (11:10) — Defending champion Paramus Catholic is the best team in Bergen County, but if any of the Paladins' top five have a sub-par race, Ridgewood and Bergen Catholic will have a chance to regain the crown they controlled from 1973 to 1986.

Defending champion Kevin McCabe of Ridgewood will compete, but Mark Bednarz and Dave Pataky of Paramus Catholic, and perhaps Ted Michaels of Bergen Catholic, are the race favorites.

Group 1 girls (12:15 p.m.) — If it was healthy, Saddle Brook would be favored to win its fourth title in six years. But the injuries that have sidelined defending champion Cathy Acevedo make the race wide open.

Palisades Park, Cresskill, and North Arlington become the favorites. Individually, look for Bergen County Scholastic League National/Olympic champion Jessica Grieco of Emerson, Cresskill's Jen Carlin, and Krissy Nuccitelli of Saddle Brook to battle for the title.

Group 2 girls (12:35) — With the departure of defending champion Dumont to Group 3, Garfield hopes to repeat its outstanding Bergen-Passaic Scholastic League performance here.

But BCSL American runner-up River Dell will contend for the title and BCSL National champion Rutherford also can challenge. Defending champion Keough and BCSL American winner Cathy Rindge of River Dell should contend for the title.

Group 1 boys (12:55) — Waldwick shoots for its first title with BCSL National champion Bogota looking for its sixth championship. Leonia, Emerson, and Bechtown are in contention for the third spot.

The individual battle is a two-man race between John Zurfleuh of Waldwick and Kevin Ryan of Bogota.

Group 2 boys (1:15) — Rutherford should become the ninth different champion in as many years.

The NJJIL meet is Tuesday at Garret Mountain. There is one boys race and one girls race, but the scoring is by divisions.

The top three finishers in last year's boys meet return, but it is

unlikely Kevin McCabe of Ridgewood will be in good enough shape to repeat last year's winning performance. Look for Sean Henry of Clifton, Mark Bednarz of Paramus Catholic, and perhaps last year's ninth-place finisher, Dave Pataky of Paramus Catholic, to battle for the title. WEST PATERSON — Ridgewood girls coach Jacob Brown has a simple method for getting his team prepared for the Bergen County cross-country Meet of Champions each year.

"I get the rotating championship trophy out of the case and show it to the team," said Brown. "Then I remind them how long we've had it."

Ridgewood retained the trophy for the ninth consecutive year after an impressive 34-56 victory over Bergenfield Saturday at Garret Mountain.

The Ridgewood boys also won handily, 61-91-96, over Ramsey and Rutherford.

Individually, Lynne Collazo of Ridgewood upset teammate Jean Hughes to win the girls title, and junior Craig Masker of Mahwah outdueled sophomore Ken Flynn of Ramsey in an exciting boys race.

Ridgewood's girls team seemed vulnerable after a comparatively weak performance by their fourth and fifth runners at the county Group 4 championship last week. Sophomore Stephanie Kane took more than 1½ minutes off her time of last Saturday and finished 12th. Combined with a fifth-place finish by fellow sophomore Liz Figlar, the Maroons survived a fine team performance by Bergenfield, which placed its top six runners from 15th to 31st.

"I didn't feel that much pressure on me," said Kane. "We did a lot of work in the last week and I haven't been fooling around at practice anymore. I knew I had to do well for us to do well."

Collazo, who defeated Hughes by 20 yards in a comparatively slow 19 minutes, 54.1 seconds, was surprised by her victory.

"I have never felt that I'm nearly as good a cross-country runner as Jean is and I still consider her the best cross-country runner in Bergen County," said Collazo. "It doesn't feel like I really won."

Collazo's sub-20 performance at Tuesday's Northern New Jersey Interscholastic League meet gave the state's premier 800-meter runner confidence that she could take the final step to cross-country prominence.

"It was over a minute faster

than I had ever run before and I never thought I could run that fast for 5,000 meters," said Collazo.

Mahwah's Dee Keough was third, followed by Garfield's Gina Fedorchak, Figlar, and Cliffside Park's Lora Matteis.

"I'm really happy about the way our girls ran," said Bergenfield coach Frank Schorling. "We had each of our girls run a personal best and they finished within 53 seconds of each other. We made Ridgewood work for the title."

Masker fought off a surge from Flynn in the final 600 meters to win.

"I wanted to know where [Paramus Catholic's Mark] Bednarz was when we hit the bathroom on the final hill," said Masker, a junior. "When they said he was way back, I took off. I didn't want him to get a chance to outkick me."

Masker won by 25 yards over Flynn in a season-best 16:19.7 to become the second Thunderbird to win the title. Ian Leavesley won the 1979 race.


"When the season started, I was just hoping I could make second team All-County," said Masker. "Then after the Passaic Coaches meet, I thought I could be top five."

But the day's top performance in last week's group meet convinced Masker that he had a chance to win.

Flynn ran a career-best 16:25 for second, staying with Masker until the final 200 yards. Bednarz was third and Mahwah senior Jim Heaney was fourth, just ahead of Paramus Catholic's Dave Pataky.

The Ridgewood boys team continued to improve in leaps and bounds to earn its third Meet of Champions victory in five seasons. Defending Bergen County champion Kevin McCabe continued his recovery from a broken foot to finish sixth to lead the Maroons, who took six of the first 29 places. Junior Jon Berntsen recovered from a poor NNJIL race to finish 10th and sophomore Eric Boucher was 11th.

Ramsey and Rutherford both ran sound team races, and should contend for state sectional championships this weekend. Bergen Catholic was fourth, and defending champion Paramus Catholic faded to fifth place.

Ridgewood girls run to county apex again

In what sport can an athlete who finishes in 36th place be a hero? Cross country, of course, and the 36th-place finish of Ridgewood High senior Nicole MacLellan in the Bergen County Meet of Champions was just as important as senior Lynne Collazo's 19:54.1 winning mark in that team victory.

Depth is the key in this sport, and that balance of talent has been the Maroons' trademark for the nine straight years they have held what was supposed to be a rotating trophy.

The Maroons also won the NJNJL Atlantic Division and Bulldog Invitational titles this fall, and coach Jacob Brown said this is a team that was able to accomplish all that it could accomplish. "I was pleased with that."

"I feel real good about this team," the 15-year coach said. "I like the way they came together. They did a good job. Kearny, with four runners back from last year's state championship team, was just too good. In the others, they rose to the occasion."

Seniors Lynne Collazo and Jean Hughes led the way. Hughes was the early-season pacesetter but Colazzo came on strong at season's end to capture the county Meet of Champions individual title and

finish second in the North Jersey sectional Group 4 race.

Kearny's Liz Duarte was the sectional winner in 20:23, with Colazzo clocked in 20:33 on the rainy day. Hughes, who was second in the county event at Garret Mountain in 20:00, was fifth in Section I in 20:55. She turned in an outstanding 19:22 effort to win the league race at Garret.

Sophomores Liz Figlar and Steph Kane have been consistent third and fourth-place finishers for the Maroons, with MacLellan in the fifth spot. Senior Janet Titus and junior Heather Fitzgerald are the sixth and seventh runners.


Bergenfield and Passaic provided the toughest competition for the Maroons on the area level.

The college ranks are dotted with former Maroon stars, including Margaret Scutro and Karen Cannon at Georgetown, Nancy Titus, Wagner; Kathy Shevlin, St. Michael's (Vermont); Amy Donnelly, Holy Cross; Noreen D'Arcy, West Point, and Jennifer Hughes, St. Joseph's (Philadelphia).

The team fielded 17 runners this season, but with injuries usually 12 or 13 competed. While Figlar, Kane and Fitzgerald will return next autumn, a slender freshman turnout leaves Brown with concern about continued Maroon supremacy.

All-Star team points toward bright future

After years of domination by state champion runners such as Toni Ann Angione of Bergenfield, Margaret Scutro of Ridgewood, Amy Kempf of Paramus, and Mary Ellen McGowan of Pascack Valley, this year's All-Bergen team members have had good but not outstanding scholastic cross-country seasons.

And even though, for the first time, no Bergen County team or individual ran in the State Meet of Champions, the future looks bright. There are only seven seniors on the three All-Bergen girls cross-country teams, including Lynne Collazo and Jean Hughes of Ridgewood and Gina Fedorchak of Garfield on first team.

But the future of Bergen County cross-country is in runners such as sophomores Vickee Foy of Paramus and Cathy Rindle of River Dell and juniors Dee Keough of Mahwah and Kim Sheekey of Ramsey, who are also on the first team. They may lead a Bergen resurgence next year.

Here's a look at the team:

LYNNE COLLAZO, Ridgewood — She may be better known as the state's best half-miler, but Collazo also managed to become the Bergen County cross-country champion. She had a good season before the Northern New Jersey Interscholastic League meet, finishing fifth in the Bulldog Invitational A race, 11th in the Shore Coaches A race, and eighth in the Ridgewood Invitational C race. Collazo then finished second in the Bergen Group 4 race before running her career best of 19:32 to finish second in the NNJIL to Hughes. That set up her upset of Hughes in the Bergen County championship. She was second in the Group 4 sectional championship before a sub-par final race in the Group 4 championship. Her 19:32 time at Garret Mountain is 38th all-time, 17th by a Bergen runner.

GINA FEDORCHAK, Garfield — Fedorchak was the veteran who led Garfield to its first County Group title and first undefeated dual meet season. She finished fourth in the Bulldog Invitational B race, took eighth in the Ridgewood Invitational A race, and finished second in the Bergen-Passaic Scholastic League King Division race. She then took third in the Bergen Group 2 race and a surprising fourth in the Bergen County Meet of Champions with a career-best time of 20:34 at Garret Mountain, the sixth fastest time of the year by a Bergen runner.

VICKEE FOY, Paramus — Moving up from second team last year, Foy made All-Bergen despite not competing in the Bergen Meet of Champions because she and four others, including Sheekey, took the wrong route and cut about 200 yards from the Garret Mountain course. But before and

after that race, Foy had an excellent year. She finished seventh in the Season Opener A race, seventh in the Bulldog A race, and third in the Eastern States C race. She then finished fourth in the NNJIL race in her seasonal-best time of 20:18, fourth fastest of the year. She took third in the Group 3 sectional meet and was 25th in the Group 3 state championship.

JEAN HUGHES, Ridgewood — Hughes made the team for the third consecutive year, although her season was not quite up to her expectations. She won the Bulldog Invitational A championship impressively and then captured the Shore Coaches A race in 19:53 at Holmdel, the 23rd fastest time run by a Bergen-Passaic athlete. A seventh-place finish in the Ridgewood Invitational A race followed before Hughes snapped back with impressive victories in the Bergen Group 4 and NNJIL races, the latter in 19:22, the 30th fastest time in history and 11th by a Bergen runner. She then finished second in the Bergen Meet of Champions, fifth in the Group 4 state sectional, and 22nd in the state Group 4 championship.

DEE KEOUGH, Mahwah — Another three-time All-Bergen selection, Keough suffered through an injury-filled season, but still managed to excel in county races. She took third in the Passaic Coaches B race, then won the B-PSL King Division race in a seasonal best of 20:13, the third best time by a Bergen runner in 1988. She then finished second in the County Group 2 race, took third in the Bergen County Meet of Champions, and second in the sectional Group 2 race. She then finished 27th in the state Group 2 race.

CATHY RINDGE, River Dell — She moves up from third team after a solid season, which included major championship victories in the Cumberland Run, Bergen Group 2, and Bergen County Scholastic League American championship; eighth-place finishes in the Season Opener B, Bulldog Invitational B, and Shore Coaches C races; and perhaps her best race of the year, an impressive second-place finish in the Ridgewood Invitational A race. She also finished eighth in the Bergen Meet of Champions, fifth in the sectional Group 2 race, and 19th in the Group 2 state championship.

KIM SHEEKEY, Ramsey — Another victim of the Group 3 mishap, Sheekey moves up from third team. She finished fifth in the Season Opener A race, and had her best race in an impressive Shore Coaches C third-place finish, sparking Ramsey to a stunning victory. She came back after the County disqualification to easily win the Northern Bergen Interscholastic League title and was fifth in the state sectional Group 3 race. She finished 48th in the state Group 3 championship.
